

# Highlights

U.S. crude oil refinery inputs averaged 16.1 million barrels per day during the week ending February 13, 2026, which was 77 thousand barrels per day more than the previous week's average. Refineries operated at 91.0% of their operable capacity last week. Gasoline production increased last week, averaging 9.4 million barrels per day. Distillate fuel production increased by 28 thousand barrels per day last week, averaging 4.9 million barrels per day.

U.S. crude oil imports averaged 6.5 million barrels per day last week, decreased by 281 thousand barrels per day from the previous week. Over the past four weeks, crude oil imports averaged about 6.3 million barrels per day, 1.3% less than the same four-week period last year. Total motor gasoline imports (including both finished gasoline and gasoline blending components) last week averaged 353 thousand barrels per day, and distillate fuel imports averaged 199 thousand barrels per day.

U.S. commercial crude oil inventories (excluding those in the Strategic Petroleum Reserve) decreased by 9.0 million barrels from the previous week. At 419.8 million barrels, U.S. crude oil inventories are about 5% below the five year average for this time of year. Total motor gasoline inventories decreased by 3.2 million barrels from last week and are about 3% above the five year average for this time of year. Both finished gasoline and blending components inventories decreased last week. Distillate fuel inventories decreased by 4.6 million barrels last week and are about 5% below the five year average for this time of year. Propane/propylene inventories decreased 3.1 million barrels from last week and are about 39% above the five year

average for this time of year. Total commercial petroleum inventories decreased by 19.1 million barrels last week.

Total products supplied over the last four-week period averaged 21.2 million barrels per day, 4.1% above the same period last year. Over the past four weeks, motor gasoline product supplied averaged 8.5 million barrels per day, 1.5% above the same period last year. Distillate fuel product supplied averaged 4.4 million barrels per day over the past four weeks, up by 2.5% from the same period last year. Jet fuel product supplied was down 1.9% compared with the same four-week period last year.

The price for West Texas Intermediate crude oil was \$63.05 per barrel February 13, 2026, \$0.72 less than a week ago, and \$8.00 less than a year ago. The New York Harbor spot price for conventional gasoline was \$1.914 per gallon, \$0.265 less than a week ago, and \$0.247 less than the year-ago price. The spot price for No. 2 heating oil at New York Harbor was \$2.287 per gallon, \$0.084 more than a week ago, and \$0.071 less than the price last year.

The national average retail price for regular gasoline increased to \$2.924 per gallon on February 16, 2026, \$0.022 more than last week's price, and \$0.224 less than the year-ago price. The national average retail diesel fuel price increased \$0.023 to \$3.711 per gallon, \$0.034 more than the price one year ago.
